To date I have not received any reply of any kind from your Office to the email I sent to you through the TAS (The Appeal Service of Northern Ireland) Office on February 17th 2023. Similarly, regarding the very closely related letter -- which was basically a signed copy of a printout of the February 17th 2023 email in question -- that I also sent to you through the registered post on February 17th 2023.
