Dear Mr Finnerty

Your housing benefit was suspended on 4/9/19, on 31/5/19 we wrote to you asking for bank statements, confirmation of any capital or any property owned by yourself and we stated in the letter we required this information by 1/7/19 or your housing benefit would be suspended. Dear UK Secretary of State for Justice Robert Buckland QC MP,

RE: THE CANCELLATION OF MY PENSION CREDIT PAYMENTS, AND THE SUSPENSION OF MY HOUSING BENEFIT PAYMENTS

Last Thursday (September 11th 2019) I sent a letter through the registered post to the **Appeal Service of Northern Ireland** regarding the sudden cancellation of my Pension Credit payments on March 21st last, which was implemented without warning and without notification. I only found out about the cancellation by accident while looking through my bank statements for information on an entirely unrelated matter some weeks later.

The full text of my September 11th 2019 letter to the Appeal Service of Northern Ireland is reproduced in the section immediately below; and, as I have indicated in the text, I am deeply concerned regarding the way that no account appears (to me) to have been taken of several pieces of information relating to my case, which I feel should have been taken into account.

Normally, I would of course wait to hear from the Appeal Service of Northern Ireland to learn what it had decided regarding my appeal, before taking any further further relating to the set of difficulties in question. However, last Friday (September 12th 2019) I received a letter from Ms Colette McCorry (Belfast District Manager of the Northern Ireland Housing Executive) informing me that my Housing Benefit payments have now been suspended. The reason for this suspension is stated as failure by me to provide information requested earlier by Mc McCorry, before a specified date. Please know that the reason for my delay in providing Ms Corry with the information she has requested from me relates directly to the fact that I was waiting for a reply to a question I raised with Ms Joanne Gordon (Decision Maker) at the Northern Ireland Pension Service Service which is referred to in the fifth paragraph of the letter text reproduced in the section below.

Although I feel very strongly that it would be best -- for the purpose of trying to avoid yet more complications relating to my overall situation -- for me to wait until after I have learned the result of my November 11th 2019 appeal from the Appeal Service of Northern Ireland, I still do not have any professional legal representation to advice me regarding this particular approach. This is the main reason I am writing to you now, and my hope is that you, or one of your qualified lawyer colleagues perhaps, might be in a position to advise me as to whether, or not, I should wait until after I hear from the Appeal Service of Northern Ireland before providing Ms Colette McCorry with the information she requires from me?

Finally, I feel I should point out that several months ago I wrote to your recently resigned predecessor, former UK Secretary of State for Justice David Gauke MP, requesting help regarding the difficulties I have been experiencing with finding professional legal representation. Dear Sir/Madam,

I wish to appeal the decision connected with the attached five-page "Reconsideration Decision" set of papers, which I received as part of a letter dated August 14th 2019 from Ms Joanne Gordon (Decision Maker) on behalf of the Department for Communities. Please know that, for some reason unknown to me, the August 14th 2019 letter in question was not delivered to my address until August 27th 2019.

A scanned copy of Ms Gordon's letter to me of August 14th 2019, together with a scanned copy of the associated five-page "Reconsideration Decision" set of papers, can be viewed at the following www location: <http://www.humanrightsireland.com/PensionService/14August2019/Letter.htm>

As can be seen at the above www address, part of the text on Page 1 of Joanne Gordon's letter to me of August 14th 2019 reads as follows:

"We have taken into account all the information available."

I have a problem trying to understand, and to accept, the statement of Ms Gordon's referred to in quotes immediately above, and this is partly because I sent a letter to Ms Gordon through the registered post on July 18th 2019 requesting an answer from her regarding the matter of whether, or not, the Northern Ireland Pension Service still required "the legally binding agreement" referred to in the final two paragraphs of my July 18th 2019 letter to Ms Gordon, a scanned copy of which can be viewed at: <http://www.humanrightsireland.com/PensionService/18July2019/RegisteredLetter.htm>

I was waiting for what I hoped would be a straightforward and clear answer to the question of mine to Ms Gordon referred

to in the paragraph immediately above; and, if I had been clearly informed that the Pension Service did still require "the legally binding agreement", it was my intention to then start making enquiries about the costs involved: while bearing in mind that a) two law firms would need to be involved (one in the Republic of Ireland and the second in Northern Ireland), and b) that, despite my best efforts over the past several years, I have still not managed to find any professional legal representation in Northern Ireland of the kind which recognises and supports (in practical ways) those parts of human rights law, and of constitutional law, which I feel are being violated with impunity, and thus sustaining, and adding to, the growing set of living problems I have been constantly struggling with for the past twenty years or so.

Also difficult for me to understand, and to accept, is the fact that neither Ms Gordon's letter to me of August 14h 2019, nor the contents of the associated five-page set of "Reconsideration Decision" papers (both referred to above), contain any reference to the letter I sent through the registered post to the Officer in Charge of the Northern Ireland Pension Service on February 18th 2019. Neither does **any account** appear (to me) to have been taken by Ms Gordon of the contents of the letter I sent through the registered post to Consultant Psychiatrist Dr Paul Bell on November 3rd 2018, which was referred to in the text of letter at the www page location immediately above. Collectively, these unresolved problems are severely exacerbating the symptoms of the Complex Post Traumatic Stress Disorder I am suffering from. #1) I have not received any reply to the "Request for help" letter I sent to recently retired UK Minister of State David Gauke MP through the registered post on April 23rd 2019, and consequently I do not know where to turn to now for professional legal help of the kind which would enable me to deal with -- in an integrated and comprehensive way -- the set of several unresolved legal and medical difficulties I have referred to in the enclosed copy of my November 3rd 2018 letter to Consultant Psychiatrist Dr Paul Bell.
