**TO WHOM IT MAY CONCERN**

Attached please find copy of a four-page letter dated September 9<sup>th</sup> 2015 from Ms Marjorie Dolan (half-sister of William Finnerty) which contains information relating to monthly loans provided for William Finnerty against his now derelict home at the following address:

“St Albans”, New Inn, Ballinasloe, County Galway, Republic of Ireland.

The loans have been provided on a regular monthly basis over a period of some years by Mr Gerald Finnerty (brother of William Finnerty), and by Marjorie Dolan: who both live in New Inn, County Galway, Republic of Ireland.

Page 3 of the attached letter consists of a signed statement from Marjorie Dolan regarding the overall sum (Euros 20,000) that she has lent to William Finnerty.

Page 4 of the attached letter consists of a signed statement from Gerald Finnerty regarding the overall sum (Euros 45,000) he has lent to William Finnerty.

William Finnerty borrowed the above-mentioned sums of money in the belief that he would be able to pay back all of the money borrowed when he received the money he believed he would be paid in connection with the old age pension he should be receiving from the Republic of Ireland Government since March 2011.

In the event, and for no good reason whatsoever (known to William Finnerty), the Republic of Ireland Government has refused to pay William Finnerty the old age pension he believes he is lawfully entitled to since he formally applied for it on March 16<sup>th</sup> 2011. Consequently, he has not been able to pay back any of the Euros 65,000 (Euros 20,000 plus Euros 45,000) referred to above.

It is also the case that William Finnerty is **entirely powerless** to challenge the Government of the Republic of Ireland regarding the above-mentioned matter of the non-payment of his old age pension. This is because he is unable to find any **legal representation** of the kind which (#1) recognises the factual existence of national and international legislation based on the **United Nations Universal Declaration of Human Rights (1948)**; and (#2), is prepared to use it in practical ways for the purpose of challenging the Government of the Republic of Ireland regarding this and other matters: a fact which is very severely exacerbating the **Complex-Post Traumatic Stress Disorder (C-PTSD)** which William Finnerty has been suffering from for several years now.
