Dear Mr. Finnerty,

Thank you for your letters dated 13 May and 25 May 2015 last.

As per my previous correspondence the only matters that should concern you in advance of 8 July 2015 are the following:-

1. Please make an appointment to see me for the purpose of running through the Garda evidence;
2. Attend with Dr. Deirdre Mulryan for the purpose of obtaining an updated medical report;
3. Attend in person at Loughrea District Court on the 10th July 2015 next.

If it is the case that you are claiming you are unfit to attend trial or to be heard in court an application would have to be made under the Criminal Law Insanity Act. The District Justice may then order that you be assessed by a mental health professional and if he deemed fit, order that you be committed to a mental health facility to assess your mental condition. Unfortunately, as you have not attended with me, Dr. Mulryan or attended court as requested it is impossible to draw any conclusions on this aspect of matters.

I cannot proceed without your co-operation.
